STRATEGIC FOCAL POINTS

for Boards Committed to Trust-Based Philanthropy

As the key governing body, a foundation's board of trustees supports executive leadership and ensures that the organization delivers on its mission as a charitable entity. Beyond their core legal duties (duty of care, loyalty, and obedience), trustbased boards play a vital role in guiding the organization's overarching strategy and culture vis a vis their values. Below are four, non-mutually exclusive focal points in which foundation boards can direct their time and attention when stewarding a grantmaking organization committed to trust-based philanthropy:

LEARNING		 Cultivate a practice of active learning around the complexity & nuance of the work you support. Reinforce a culture of learning & reflection. Focus accountability on how the foundation embodies its values & intentions. 	 How do we orient our learning towards social transformation, rather than transaction? Who must we listen to and learn from to better understand the ecosystem(s) we are part of? How can we prioritize learning from one another, peers, staff, & grantee partners? 	 Engage in dialogue to deepen understanding of context, partners, and potential impact. Facilitate learning exchanges with funder peers & grantee partners. Review and discuss stories, reports, case studies, and grantee feedback.
STRATEGY		 Clarify & define foundation's values. Iterate and evolve foundation's strategy to align with values. Ensure that strategic plans are responsive to communities the foundation is accountable to. 	 What does our org stand for, and how can we reinforce a shared understanding among staff & board? What are we aiming to accomplish with our grantmaking, investment portfolio, and relationships? What external & internal factors do we track to understand our progress? 	 Strategic forecasting. Seek out values-aligned investment strategies. Regularly reflect on internal & external learnings; adjust plans based on emergent contexts & realities.
GRANTMAKING		• Partner with staff to align overall grant strategy with mission, vision, and values.	 How does our grantmaking embody our values? How does our grantmaking deliver on our mission and advance our vision? 	 In partnership with staff, set, review, and approve strategic priorities and budgets for grantmaking. Occasionally, approve larger grants and/or new investments that fall outside of overarching budget and strategy.
IMAGINATION		 Cultivate aspirational, values-based collective imagination for a more just future. 	 What is the future we seek to live into? How do we help create the conditions for such a future? Who and what stretches our imaginations? 	 Nurture and resource imagination & spirit with nature, art, community, & rest. Value staff's heart & intuition, alongside intellect.
